CBU invites applications for a tenure-track position in Mathematics at the rank of Assistant Professor to commence July 2009, subject to budget approval.

Applicants must have a Ph.D. in Mathematics. Related postdoctoral research and teaching experience is desirable. The successful candidate will contribute to teaching upper level undergraduate courses in such areas as real analysis, complex analysis and set theory. The research specialization should be relevant to at least one of these areas. The teaching load may include some service courses (including elementary financial mathematics and fundamentals of Mathematics).

The successful applicant will be expected to establish a vigorous externally funded research program and teach Mathematics at the undergraduate level. Applicants are expected to engage in course updating and development, and to demonstrate potential and commitment with regard to undergraduate teaching, research/creative/scholarly activities and service to Cape Breton University, community and profession.

Qualified candidates should send a letter of application quoting the reference number, a complete dossier including curriculum vitae, copy of academic transcripts, evidence of teaching effectiveness, a writing sample and three current letters of reference (sent directly to CBU) to the Human Resources Department.
