

Postdoctoral Position in Geometry & Topology

The Geometry/Topology group in the Department of Pure Mathematics at the University of Waterloo is seeking candidates for a post-doctoral position. The position will be for two years to begin on July 1, 2011, subject to funding. The successful candidate would be expected engage in research activities and to teach two courses per year within the Faculty of Mathematics.

We are seeking a candidate whose research interests are closely related to the interests of our group, which include: low dimensional topology; gauge theory; symplectic and complex geometry; arithmetic and algebraic geometry; special structures in Riemannian geometry; and applications of geometry to physics. Each applicant must submit an application package containing a curriculum vitae, a short statement of research interests and goals, and at least three letters of recommendation, one of which should address the applicant's teaching experience.
