The Department of Mathematical Sciences at Lakehead University (Thunder Bay Campus) invites applications for a postdoctoral position. The position is for one year, starting August 1, 2011. The successful candidate will be expected to engage in research and teach three one semester courses. The position is subject to budgetary approval.

Applicants must have completed a PhD in Mathematics before the beginning of the appointment. Preference will be given to candidates whose research interests complement those of current faculty. In particular, preference will be given to the following areas: algebra (commutative algebra, group rings), analysis (classical analysis, abstract harmonic analysis, C*-algebras, von Neumann algebras, Banach spaces, operator theory), numerical analysis, mathematical physics, operations research, probability and statistics.
