With Bachelor's and Master's level degrees in all disciplines, Doctoral programs are available in Biology, Biochemistry, Chemistry, Computer Science, Earth Sciences, Statistics, and Physics. Opportunities for interdisciplinary, inter-faculty and concurrent degree programs are also available. While a separate entity, the Great Lakes Institute for Environmental Research is closely
