The director's duties will be the following:

- 3. To actively search for external funding.

The director is appointed for a four-year term which can be renewed only once for a second four-year term. Salary will be determined according to his/her experience and qualifications, starting at 100.000 EURO per year.

The director is required to establish residence in Spain, to have experience in research and management, and a working knowledge of Spanish.
