

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR POSITIONS IN MATHEMATICS

For the second position we are looking for researchers working in the areas of **numerical analysis** or **scientific computing**.

We seek applicants with an outstanding, independent research program and a strong commitment to undergraduate and graduate teaching. The successful candidate(s) will contribute to an active, innovative department with strong research groups and a thoughtful teaching environment.

All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadians and Permanent Residents of Canada will be given priority.
