

Department of Pure Mathematics University of Waterloo

The Department of Pure Mathematics in the Faculty of Mathematics at the University of Waterloo invites applications for a tenure-track or tenured position in any area of pure mathematics, at the rank of Assistant, Associate or Full Professor.

A PhD degree and evidence of excellence in research and teaching are required. A successful applicant will be expected to have an outstanding research program or outstanding potential for research, attract and supervise graduate students, and participate in undergraduate and graduate teaching.

The appointment is expected to commence on July 1, 2016. The salary range for this position is \$100,000 – \$160,000. Negotiations beyond this salary range will be considered for exceptionally qualified candidates.

Applications must include a cover letter, a curriculum vitae, a research statement and at least four letters of reference, one of which should specifically address teaching.
