Both positions are at the Lakehead-Georgian (Barrie) campus. The first position is for a three-year term, the second is for a nine-month term. Applicants for the three-year position will automatically be considered for the nine-month position as well. These appointments will commence on August 15, 2019 and salary will be dependent on qualifications and experience.

The electronic application (in the form of one PDF document) should include: a letter of interest, curriculum vitae, evidence of teaching effectiveness (including a statement of teaching philosophy, course outlines and teaching evaluations for previously-taught courses), a statement of a research plan (current and future interests), copies of the three most significant publications, and the names and contact information of three references.
